Future Skills Bootcamp at Government Senior Secondary School, Bajawa Suron Ka

In August, UdayKriti conducted a two-day immersive Future Skills Bootcamp at *Government Senior Secondary School, Bajawa Suron Ka*.

The programme brought together 58 enthusiastic students, introducing them to OpenAI tools, the basics of web development and the art of creating no-code websites within minutes, thanks to BrandRemaster and Mr. Divyanshu for his support.

For many participants, it was their first-ever exposure to the world of artificial intelligence — most had never even heard of ChatGPT before. What began with curiosity soon turned into excitement as they realised how technology could become a tool for *self-expression*, *employability*, and *empowerment*. The bootcamp was about building confidence, generating curiosity and a belief that potential knows no postcode.

Empowering Changemakers: Capacity Building for NGOs

Continuing our commitment to strengthening the social sector, Ms. Jaswant Kaur, Founder of UdayKriti, conducted a capacity-building workshop on “Resource Utilisation” at *Vishwa Yuvak Kendra*, New Delhi, as part of their five-day residential programme on NGO Management.

The session engaged 69 representatives from diverse NGOs, exploring practical frameworks for optimising time, talent, and funds to enhance organisational impact. Participants were also introduced to emerging technologies like Generative AI and how these can be leveraged for operational efficiency and innovation in the social sector.

The workshop concluded with a powerful reminder that resourcefulness is not just about resources, it is also about perspective.



Curating safer Workplaces: the POSH way

It is a matter of immense pride that our Founder, Ms. Jaswant Kaur, was invited to conduct a sensitisation workshop on building safe workplaces for women under the POSH Act with nearly 200 employees of the Scientific Analysis Group (SAG) Lab, Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO).

It was a privilege to facilitate an engaging and interactive session that aimed to bust myths and misconceptions while deepening understanding of key concepts such as *what constitutes sexual harassment, what defines a workplace, and what falls under the purview of the law.*

This collaboration reflected UdayKriti's reaffirmed our belief that *safe workplaces are the foundation of empowered workforces.*
